

**Printing and assembly Instructions for patient education pamphlet:
“The PSA test for prostate cancer: Is it Right for ME?”**

If you would like to print the patient education pamphlet entitled “The PSA test for prostate cancer: Is it Right for ME?”, please use the following instructions to ensure proper assembly.

Printing instructions:

- o The pamphlet must be printed on 8.5 x 11 landscape-oriented paper (ideally at least 80 lb. Text)
- o The pamphlet document consists of four 8.5 x 11 inch landscape-oriented pages.
- o For proper assembly, these four pages must be printed on two double-sided sheets of paper.
- o Print the first two pages of the pamphlet document back to back on one sheet of paper (sheet 1). The front and back covers of the final folded pamphlet are on one side of this sheet.
- o Print the second two pages of the document back to back on a second sheet of paper (sheet 2).

Assembly instructions:

- o Take **sheet one** and place it so that the front/back covers (pages 1 and 8) face down (toward the work surface).
- o Orient **sheet two** so that the side with the diagram of the prostate gland (pages 4-5) is facing up (toward assembler).
- o Place sheet two on top of sheet one.
- o Staple sheets one and two in the middle, using two evenly spaced staples, and fold so that the staple is on the crease.
- o After assembly is completed, check the page numbers to verify that they are in sequential order (pages 1-8).
- o The final pamphlet should be 8.5 inches tall and 5.5 inches wide.
